Low-Cost Feral Cat Spay/Neuter Program

About the program

- Available to anyone regardless of income
- Must show proof of living within Santa Cruz County (includes all cities)
- Cats must be brought to clinic in traps
- Kittens must be 4 months old
- FVRCP/Rabies vaccines and parasite control are included
- Cats/kittens are given a mandatory eartip identifying them as fixed

→ **Please call BEFORE you trap** to ensure surgery space is available. If you fail to trap the cat, please call to reschedule

→ Drop off cats in individual traps between 7:30 - 8 a.m. before regular clinic open Monday - Friday. Pick up before 6 p.m. on the same day.

Surgeries 7 days a week

No appointment necessary

Drop off cats in individual traps before 10 a.m. (Clinic open 6 p.m. - midnight for emergencies ONLY)

→ Pick up male cats before closing, on the same day

→ Female cats **MUST** stay overnight (no charge). Call the day after surgery after 10 a.m. to arrange pickup time
